Ridgewood High School is pleased to announce our opportunities for the summer of 2022. These opportunities will only be offered in-person. Opportunities include: Extended School Year, Summer School, Driver Education, and Incoming Freshman Summer Opportunities. Information about each opportunity can be found below.

## **Extended School Year**

Students in need of additional time to complete the requirements of courses from the 2021-22 school year will have the opportunity to work toward completion of their courses during Summer 2022. Students will not be expected to pay a fee for Extended School Year (ESY). Extended School Year runs 8 - 11 A.M. from Monday, June 13th through Thursday, June 16th. During ESY, students may make up minimal missing assignments for their course(s) with a Not Met. For students who are missing significant coursework from the semester, they will begin work during ESY and continue into Summer School (see below).

## STEM Camp

Students entering 5th through 9th grade are invited to participate in this STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, and Math) camp at Ridgewood High School.



### **Summer School**

Students who do not complete course requirements in extended school year will be enrolled in Summer School. Summer School runs June 21 to July 21 from 8:00-11:00 A.M. There is no Summer School on July 4 and 5. The cost for summer school is \$200 per half credit & \$350 for a full credit. **Students can recover 1.0 full credit in summer school.** If your student needs more than one credit, please contact Katie Davis (Division Head of Student Services) at <a href="mailto:kdavis@ridgenet.org">kdavis@ridgenet.org</a> to discuss options.

For students that need credit recovery or elective/enrichment credits, the cost is \$200 per half credit and \$350 for the full credit. Credit Recovery and elective/enrichment courses are completed using a digital curriculum/online platform called Edgenuity.
