

2022 Ridgewood High School Parents' Club Scholarship

The Ridgewood Parents' Club scholarships are one-year, non-renewable awards that are open to any Ridgewood student who meets specific eligibility criteria. All scholarships are payable to the community college, university/college, or postsecondary (technical or trade) degreed program of the student's choice.

Eligibility

- 1. Applicants must be currently enrolled in Ridgewood High School District 234.
- 2. Applicants must be a senior, graduating the current school year.
- 3. Applicants must be in good standing within the community, having never been convicted of a felony.
- Applicant must be enrolling in a community college, university/college, or post-secondary (technical or trade) degreed program for the first term following the student's graduation.
- Application must be received by 3:00PM on Friday, March 11th, 2022. Return to Ridgewood High School, 7500 W Montrose Ave. Norridge, IL 60706, Attn: Parents' Club Scholarship. LATE APPLICATIONS WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED.

<u>Awards</u>

 A maximum of \$2,000 in scholarships will be awarded. Scholarships will be payable directly to the winners' identified post-secondary institutions any time after July 1, 2022 and upon receipt of definite proof of enrollment in a community college, university/college, or postsecondary school (technical or trade) degreed program. Proof of enrollment may include a statement from the office of the registrar with the seal of the school or a statement on school letterhead signed by a school official. Scholarship winners who exit their program prior to the successful completion of the first term following the year of their graduation will be expected to refund the total amount of the scholarship to Ridgewood High School Parents' Club.

2. If you have not made a final decision about your post-secondary plans, you are still eligible to apply for the scholarship. You are required to notify Ridgewood High School Parents' Club once you have made your decision.

Instructions

- 1. Complete the Ridgewood High School Parents' Club application in its entirety.
- 2. Attach a copy of the attached resume.
- 3. Attach the completed and signed School Enrollment Verification Form.
- 4. Attach your current official high school transcript.
- 5. Type and attach your 350-word essay around the following question:

Tell us about an experience you had where you gave of yourself to help an individual or group. How did that experience shape your view of yourself and how has that awareness been integrated into other aspects of your life?

- Attach your two personal recommendation letters <u>pertaining to this</u> <u>scholarship</u>. One from a teacher, guidance counselor, or other school official. The other from an unrelated individual who is not employed by Ridgewood High School with whom the applicant has worked on a job or community volunteer service activity.
