Grading Reminders for Semester 1

Semester 1 ended on January 13th. Semester 1 report cards and unofficial transcripts have been finalized and are now posted in Skyward Family Access. To access the report card or unofficial transcript, follow the directions below:

- 1. Log into Skyward Family Access
- 2. On the left hand side, click on the Portfolio tab
- 3. Click on the "2022-23 Semester 1 Report Card" or "Unofficial Transcript" hyperlink

If your student earned one or more Not Met(s) (NM) for semester 1, they may need to attend summer school if the course is required for graduation. If your student does not attend summer school, they will be in jeopardy of not graduating with their class.

#### Summer School Information

Summer School runs from June 12-July 20 Monday through Thursday from 8:00-11:00 A.M. There will NOT be Summer School on June 19<sup>th</sup>, July 3<sup>rd</sup>, and July 4<sup>th</sup>.

The cost will be \$200 per half credit and \$350 for 1 credit. Students will be able to make up one full credit in summer school. #### 5Essentials Survey

We are writing to inform you about a student survey that will be administered at your child's school called the Illinois 5Essentials Survey. The 5Essentials is an evidence-based system designed to drive improvement in schools nationwide—it reliably measures changes in a school organization through the 5Essentials Survey and provides individualized, actionable Reports for each school. This survey is based on 20 years of research at the University of Chicago. It asks students about their experiences in school, giving school leaders critical student input to help develop school improvement plans.

Under recent legislation (Public Act 100-1046), the State Board is now mandated, on an annual basis, to implement a learning conditions survey. Student participants will be required to log-in using their student state ID and birth date in order to complete the survey. Students' identities will be completely confidential. Teachers or administrators will never see individual responses to survey questions and will only receive aggregated information, such as the total percentage of students who agree homework assignments help them learn the course material. ### COVID Testing Reminder

RHS still offers optional, weekly, and free COVID testing available for all students. Testing occurs every Thursday during all lunch periods. Participants can choose between a nasal or inner cheek swab, and results are communicated within 24-48 hrs

#### District 234 Board Waives Fees for Next School Year - 2023-2024 School Year

High School District 234's Board of Education will waive select fees for all students for the 2023-2024 school year. Board members voted on December 12th to place a one-year moratorium on school fees for next school year in response to continuing uncertainties in the community linked to the pandemic. District 234 has identified cost savings elsewhere and has applied for temporary federal funding for technology needs to offset revenue typically generated by fees. Student fees that will be waived next year include, technology, registration, digital learning, instructional materials, course fees, and locks (for freshmen and new students). Fees that will not be waived include, but are not limited to replacement locks, yearbooks, summer driver's education, late fees, summer school, charges for damage to school-issued iPads & peripherals, and student parking passes.

Families will still be responsible for paying all fees for the current school year, 2022-2023.

## Elyssa's Mission Suicide Prevention Program

As the mental health crisis in teens continues to be a concern, Ridgewood High School will be offering depression awareness and a suicide prevention training as part of the Signs of Suicide (SOS) program to our Freshman students on February 2nd and February 16th. This program is funded by a nonprofit organization, Elyssa's Mission. The program aims to increase help-seeking behaviors among students concerned about themselves or a friend. Listed on SAMHSA's National Registry of Evidence-Based

Programs and Practices, the SOS program showed a reduction in self-reported suicide attempts by 40-64% in randomized control studies (Aseltine et al., 2007 & Schilling et al., 2016).

Our goals in participating in this program are:

- To help our students understand that depression is a treatable illness
- To explain that suicide is a preventable tragedy that often occurs as a result of untreated depression
- To provide students with the training on how to identify serious depression and potential suicidality in themselves or a friend
- To impress upon youth that they can help themselves or a friend by taking the simple step of talking to a responsible adult about their concerns
- To help students know whom in the school they can turn to for help, if they need it

## ACCESS Testing

The ACCESS test is the annual assessment for all K-12 English Learners (ELs) in the State of Illinois. ACCESS scores are used to assess student progress and proficiency in English as well as to help determine placement in the EL program the following school year. The test will measure their listening & reading in one session and speaking & writing in another session. The scores monitor student progress in acquiring English and to determine if a student is eligible to exit an English language support program.
